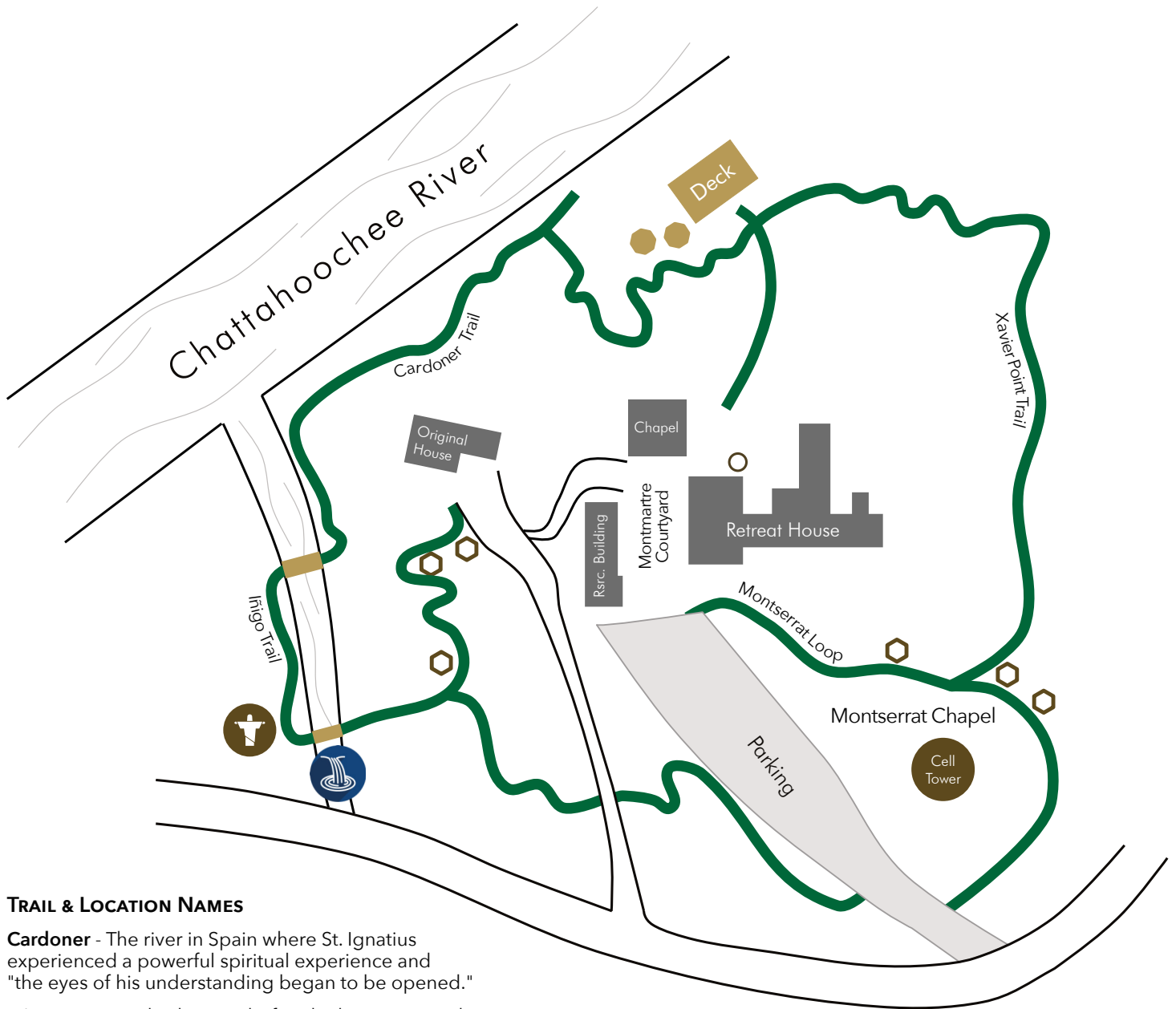


Ignatius House TRAIL MAP

TRAIL & LOCATION NAMES

Cardoner - The river in Spain where St. Ignatius experienced a powerful spiritual experience and "the eyes of his understanding began to be opened."

Inigo - Ignatius' birth name before he began using the Latin name "Ignatius."

Montserrat - Ignatius made a pilgrimage to the Benedictine abbey of Our Lady at Montserrat, where before a statue of the Black Madonna, he dedicated his life to God, made a general confession, and laid down his sword.

Xavier - St. Francis Xavier was Ignatius' roommate at the University of Paris, co-founder of the Society of Jesus, and missionary to Asia.

Montmartre - Ignatius and the First Companions made vows of poverty and chastity at Montmartre Abbey in Paris, in 1534.
